# NOTICE OF APPLICATION

## DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that an application has been filed with the City of San Diego for a Coastal Development Permit and Map Waiver (Process 3) application to waive the requirements of a Tentative Map to convert four existing residential units to condominiums on a 0.123 acre site. The property is located at 2231 Mendocino Boulevard in the RM-2-5 Zone, Coastal Overlay Zone (non-appealable), Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, Airport Approach Overlay Zone, Airport Environs Overlay Zone, North Bay Redevelopment Project Area, and Parking Impact Overlay Zone within the Peninsula Community Plan and Local Coastal Program Area and Council District 2.

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The decision to approve or deny this application will be made at a public hearing. In addition, this item will be discussed by the Community Planning Group for the area in which the project is located. They will make an advisory recommendation to the City of San Diego.

Should the condominium conversion project be approved, tenants may be required to vacate the premises. No units may be sold in this building unless the conversion is approved by the city and until after a public report is issued by the Department of Real Estate. Each tenant has the exclusive right to contract for the purchase of his or her respective unit upon the same terms and conditions that such unit will be initially offered to the general public or terms more favorable to the tenant. The right shall run for a period of not less than 90 days from the date of issuance of the subdivision public report pursuant to Section 11018.2 of the Business and Professions Code, unless the tenant gives prior written notice of his or her intention not to exercise the right.

If you are an existing tenant within this project, you may have rights to certain benefits as outlined in San Diego Municipal Code Section 144.0503. To learn more information regarding these benefits, please contact
